

**Rest-Haven Memorial Park**  
**General Information**  
**Rules and Regulations**

Rest-Haven Memorial Park was founded in the late 1920's and is planned in conformity with the latest ideas of cemetery design, and our best practice in cemetery administration will be observed in its operation and maintenance.

Rest-Haven was carefully planned so as to take advantage of the natural beauty of the site. The roads were carefully adjusted to the topography. The planting, likewise, was done in such a way as to preserve open vistas and form backgrounds. In order to preserve the unity of this landscape scene, it is necessary that no planting be done except by Rest-Haven Memorial Park in conformity with its plan, and also that no plantings be removed except with their permission.

The following rules and regulations are for the protection of lot owners and the permanent preservation of the park:

**PRIVATE PROPERTY:** Rest-Haven is a locally owned and operated private memorial park for the enjoyment of our owners, families and their guests exclusively.

**PARK HOURS:** The Park is open 9:00 am to 5:00 pm on weekdays. The office is closed on Saturday and Sunday and most holidays. The Gates/Mausoleum is open during the week from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm and 10:00 am to 5:00 pm on weekends and holidays.

**GROUNDS AND LAWNS:** Our cemetery grounds and lawns are intended to present a Pacific Northwest setting. The overall natural beauty and surroundings is what we provide. We strive to provide a peaceful and quiet break for families to enjoy the memories of their loved ones. We cannot provide nor do we have the resources to create an overly manicured single space or area. We treat all of our cemetery grounds as a unit and not individually. Seasonal conditions may impact the amount and type of work we are able to complete. If you have questions, please inquire at our office.

**FLOWERS:** All types of flowers and potted plants are permitted. Fresh, environmentally friendly arrangements are encouraged. Artificial flowers are permitted at all times, however, these arrangements will be treated the same as fresh arrangements and will be picked up one week following placement and disposed of. During mowing artificial flowers, ornaments or other decorative items will be disposed of as we mow.

Rest-Haven is not responsible for any flowers, plants or containers left at the graveside or in the mausoleum. Private plantings of flowers, shrubs and trees are not permitted.

Please be advised that we do have deer that nibble on the flowers!

**FLOWERS IN THE MAUSOLEUM:** There are flower rooms in each of the corridors for your use. Please **NO FRESH IRIS** in the mausoleum, as they stain the marble. Holiday arrangements will be picked up two weeks after the holiday and disposed of. Vases are available for use in the Vase Ring only. Memorial items are to be placed in the vase only. For assistance in placing a vase in the holder, please see attendant. Vases may not be removed from the mausoleum! Arrangements shall be cleared and disposed of at the sole judgment of the maintenance staff.

**ROADS:** Use of roads is for the convenience and transportation throughout the grounds by and for our families and invited guests. Please do not exceed 15 mph. Please follow the one-way signs and any other directions given. No commercial vehicles or heavy trucks are allowed.

**PARKING:** Parking is permitted only on the paved surface. Please pull to one side and do not park or drive on the grass.

**DOGS:** Dogs are permitted in the park on leash only. Please be responsible and respectful of the grounds. Waste must be removed by the owner from the grounds.

**CHILDREN:** No children unless attended by an adult.

**WATER:** Water for families use is located inside and outside our mausoleum and in several areas throughout the Park.

**VASES:** Permanent vases may be purchased through the Rest-Haven office. Families are responsible for cutting the grass around their vases. Temporary vases, as available, are located near the office. Temporary vases will be picked up as arrangements are cleared.

**MEMORIAL MARKERS:** Rest-Haven trims markers once a year. Additionally, each family is encouraged to trim their own as needed.

**FLAGS (MEMORIAL DAY):** Flags are available to families at our office for placement on the veteran's graves.

**SKATEBOARDS AND BICYCLES** are prohibited in the Park at all times.

**(ORS 97.710)**

Rest-Have Memorial Park may make and enforce rules and regulations for:

1. The use, care, control, management, restriction and protection of itself (Rest-Haven Memorial Park).
2. Restricting and limiting the use of all property within its cemetery.
3. Regulating the uniformity, class and kind of all markers, monuments and other structures within the cemetery.
4. Prohibiting the erection of monuments, markers or other structures in or upon any portion of the property.
5. Regulating or preventing the erection of monuments, effigies and structures within any portion of the cemetery grounds and for the removal thereof.
6. Regulating the care or preventing the introduction of plants or shrubs within the cemetery grounds.
7. Preventing the interment in any part thereof of a body or remains (cremated) not entitled to interment therein.
8. Preventing the use of burial plots for purposes violative of its restrictions.
9. Regulating the conduct of persons and preventing improper assemblages therein.
10. All other purposes deemed necessary by Rest-Haven Memorial Park for the proper conduct of business and the protection and safeguarding of the premises and the principles, plans, and ideals on which Rest-Haven Memorial Park was founded and organized.

\*Rest-Haven Memorial Park from time to time may amend, add to, revise, change or modify its rules and regulations as it deems necessary.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1.** All interments in lots shall be restricted to valid certificate holders as recorded in the records of the cemetery. Certificate holders shall not allow interments to be made in their lots for remuneration.
- 2.** No sale, transfer, or assignment of any lot or part thereof, or any interest therein, shall be valid without the consent of Rest-Haven Memorial Park, and no transfer is valid until entered on their records (lots are for the sole use of the owners) and all costs and fees paid. Any certificate or deed not held in correct name of a living person shall become null and void after 180 days and all internment rights shall return to Rest-Haven.
- 3.** No double burials (that is, one body being placed on top of another will be permitted) in single grave spaces. Double burials are permitted in areas of the cemetery so designated as “Double Depth” or “Lawn Crypts” only.
- 4.** All markers, memorials, vaults, grave boxes, or other outside products sold and placed by outside vendors are subject to the rules and regulations, administrative costs for locating, recording, inspecting, which Rest-Haven Memorial Park will impose. All outside vendors must carry liability insurance and provide proof thereof before installing any product in the park. Outside products are subject to the specifications and requirements of the cemetery. Rest-Haven Memorial Park will hold others responsible for the damage of the property, or injury to others as the result of outside vendors placing products in the park. Vendors or those authorizing the placement of outside products in the park will be responsible for any damages which may occur. All cemetery charges must be satisfied before outside products will be allowed into the cemetery grounds. Rest-Haven Memorial Park, in its sole discretion, may refuse the placement of certain products when in the best interest of the cemetery and property owners.
- 5.** All markers shall be level with the ground so as to provide a park-like environment. Markers shall be constructed of bronze or granite. All markers shall be set level with the ground and bronze markers will be set on a foundation constructed of concrete. No part of the foundation shall be placed over a grave opening. The size of single markers shall not be less than 12” x 24” or greater than 18” x 28” in dimension for adults. See current Marker specification guide for complete information on all compliance requirements.
- 6.** Heavy loads or equipment will not be permitted to enter the grounds.
- 7.** Rest-Haven Memorial Park has control of all planting. Lots are purchased subject to trees and shrubs and other plants growing on them or provided in our plans, and no tree or shrub or flower or other plant shall be planted on or removed from any lot, or pruned, without the permission of the Park Manager.
- 8.** The grade of all lots shall not be altered without the permission of the park management, and employees of Rest-Haven Memorial Park shall do all grading work.
- 9.** Graves shall be kept as level as possible.
- 10.** No ornament, décor, or other articles shall be placed on lots without the permission of park management. Rest-Haven Memorial Park reserves the right to remove any objects from lots. Vases on graves shall be depressed into the ground and shall be of a design approved by Rest-Haven Memorial Park.

**11.** All orders taken for work are subject to the rules of the park, and to guard against complaint of theft, no one, whether lot owners or holders of grave/property receipts, or otherwise, will be allowed to pluck any flower, break any limb or twig, or remove any tree or plant to take away, without the permission from Rest-Haven Memorial Park; and then if such permission is given, the work must be done by the employees of the park, for which a charge shall be made.

**12.** The throwing of rubbish on the avenues, walks or any part of the grounds is strictly prohibited.

**13.** No dis-interment will be allowed without the permission of Rest-Haven Memorial Park, or against the wishes of the lot owner, or next of kin of the deceased, except by Order of Court of competent jurisdiction and except further as provided for in Oregon State Law.

**14.** Rest-Haven Memorial Park is under no obligation to permit, nor may the purchaser demand, interment or burial in a lot or property until the full purchase price has been paid. If, however, special arrangements are made and permission is given for burial or interment before the full purchase price has been paid, and purchaser becomes in default for failure to make the payments on the purchase price/agreement, Rest-Haven Memorial Park may at its discretion when a period of 90 days has elapsed after said default and upon written notice addressed to the purchaser at the last address given by the purchaser to Rest-Haven Memorial Park, proceed to remove the body or remains buried or interred therein to some other place for interment in the cemetery grounds, or to the portion set apart for single graves, or to a smaller lot, or may set off a part of the lot in which the interments are made, at the expense of the purchasers of such lot or property, for their burial/interment, such an agreement for place of interment shall be paid in full, all money paid on the lot/property purchased, the same having been forfeited by reason of failure to complete the purchase.

**15.** The certificate holders of lots and property and their families shall be allowed access to the grounds during regular hours, observing the rules which are or may hereafter be adopted for the observance of visitors.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR INTERMENTS**

**1.** Whenever an interment is to be made, a valid certificate for “Right of Interment/Entombment” shall be presented for a pre-need property or available at-need property selected. Timely notice thereof must be given at the office of Rest-Haven Memorial Park and a permit/authorization obtained therefore, specifying the name of the person to be interred, relative or responsible person(s) authorizing interment or other services specified. The type of outside container must be specified and it must meet cemetery requirements. Valid Right of Interment/Entombment certificates specify the intended users of burial spaces at the time of issuance. All burial spaces are subject to the rules of ORS 97.510. Disputes arising involving interment rights shall be resolved by the request of a court order. Permission will be granted and issued upon the presentation and surrender of the right of interment/entombment certificate to the property. Misplaced or lost certificates may be replaced for an administrative fee.

- 2.** The legally recognized individual applying for the permit should give the following information, if known: Name of deceased, place of birth, late residence, date of death, date and time of interment, signer of death certificate, name of kindred, in whose lot/property interment is to take place, name of funeral home, size of casket, if applicable, and next of kin or responsible party must sign interment order.
- 3.** Rest-Haven Memorial Park requires that there is an outer burial container placed around the casket when an earth burial takes place. The minimum requirement of Rest-Haven Memorial Park for an outer burial container is a two piece steel reinforced concrete grave box and lid. Burial vaults are allowed which provide a seal. Rest-Haven Memorial Park reserves the right to judge which outer containers the cemetery will accept based on structural and physical aspects of the product and requirements of the park. Rest-Haven Memorial Park can require evidence and proof of structural integrity before allowing any outer burial container to be placed within the park.
- 4.** All graves will be dug, outer burial containers and markers, and vases will be placed and set by cemetery employees. Outside products are allowed to be placed within the cemetery subject to the rules, which Rest-Haven may impose for the protection of cemetery property and lot owners. All outside products are subject to locating, recording, inspecting, and other administrative fees which may result when products are placed within the park by outside vendors. Outside vendors must show proof and evidence that they carry liability insurance not less than \$100,000 when placing outside products in the park.
- 5.** Rest-Haven Memorial Park will require those authorizing the placement of outside products within the park to sign a form which releases Rest-Haven Memorial park from liability should injury or damage occur to individuals or property as the result of the placement of outside products by outside vendors. When damage or injury results the person(s) authorizing the placement of outside products will be responsible for charges when repairs or damage occurs. Rest-Haven Memorial Park does not guarantee, nor will it repair, replace or provide upkeep on products which are purchased and /or placed by outside vendors. Failed products will be removed and disposed of.
- 6.** Opening caskets or graves to view the remains is prohibited, except on the order of court of competent jurisdiction and extra charges will be made for such work.
- 7.** Prices for property and cemetery services will be established and made available to those who wish to see the charges. Charges will be itemized and subject to change at Rest-Haven Memorial Park's discretion from time to time.
- 8.** Marker prices and requirements will be made available to those who wish to see the charges. Charges and specifications will be itemized for each situation and are subject to change at Rest-Haven Memorial Park's discretion from time to time.
- 9.** When remains are removed from their interment space and not re-interred in the park, no part of the original cost of the grave will be returned. Parties making other selections in the park and removing bodies from interred spaces to such sections will be allowed the cost of the interment space, less the regular charges for dis-interring and re-interring the same.
- 10.** All rules and regulations may be amended, or addenda may be added to the rules and regulations on a continuous basis at Rest-Haven Memorial Park's discretion.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR VISITORS**

- 1.** Visitors are allowed on a daily basis.
- 2.** Visitors either on foot or in vehicles must enter by the gate; any person who shall violate this rule will be deemed a trespasser and dealt with accordingly.
- 3.** Unauthorized picnic parties, social and religious gatherings, consumption of alcohol or illegal substances are strictly forbidden and violators will be prosecuted.
- 4.** No hunting is allowed within the park and no persons with firearms will be permitted to enter the grounds, except for a military funeral.
- 5.** Dogs are permitted on the grounds on leash only, and owners are responsible to see that the cemetery grounds and surrounding property is accorded respect and dignity. Owners must be prepared to clean up as necessary.
- 6.** No children will be admitted unless attended by some responsible person who will be responsible for their conduct. Children must not be allowed to run at will over the grounds.
- 7.** Boisterousness and profane language, or any conduct tending to disturb the quiet and good order of the park is forbidden. Respectfulness and dignified behavior will be adhered to at all times while in the park.
- 8.** No money shall be paid to the attendants at the entrance or on the grounds.
- 9.** No turning of automobiles upon the roads or avenues within the park grounds or driving upon the grass or lawns will be permitted. The owners of automobiles, employers employing drivers of automobiles will be responsible for any damage resulting from the misuse of automobiles in the park.
- 10.** All persons are prohibited from plucking/cutting any flower, either wild or cultivated, breaking or injuring any tree, plant or shrub, or in any way injuring any structure or other property.
- 11.** No person shall be permitted to disturb the quiet and good order of the park in any way, and the management or employees in the park are instructed to see that proper decorum is maintained at all times, and to exclude or remove or cause to be arrested all those who at any time have violated this rule of Rest-Haven Memorial Park.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **ADDENDUM 1: Rules and Regulations for Interments:**

1. Rest-Haven Memorial Park will allow ONE of the following to be interred in a single grave space.
  - a. One casketed remains and one cremated remains.
  - b. Two sets of cremated remains.
2. Rest-Haven Memorial Park will allow only the following interments to take place in Babyland and Childland (dimensions shall dictate uses):
  - a. The remains of one casketed or cremated infant in Babyland.
  - b. The remains of one casketed or cremated child in Childland.
3. Rest-Haven Memorial Park will allow only the following to be interred in a double-depth Grave:
  - a. two casketed remains (one on top of the other). A grave box is required for both.
4. Rest-Haven Memorial park will allow only the following to be interred in Urn Garden Areas:
  - a. One or two sets of cremated remains.
5. Rest-Haven Memorial Park will allow only the following to be interred in Marble Front Niches:
  - a. One or two sets of cremated remains.
6. Rest-Haven Memorial Park will allow only the following to be interred in a Glass Front Niche:
  - a. One or two sets of cremated remains. A decorative bronze urn is required
7. Rest-Haven Memorial Park will allow the following to be entombed:
  - a. Single Crypt: one casketed remains and one set of cremated remains, or two sets of cremated remains.
  - b. Tandem Crypt: two casketed remains, one casketed & one cremated remains, or two sets of cremated remains.
  - c. Westminster: two casketed remains, one casketed & one cremated remains; or two sets of cremated remains.
  - d. Family Crypt: four casketed remains; or a combination of casketed and cremated remains totaling not more than four.
8. Markers and Name Bars will not be set until all at-need charges have been satisfied.

All interments/entombments are subject to the approval of Rest-Haven Memorial park when there is a question as to the size of the burial or interment receptacle in which the remains are held.
